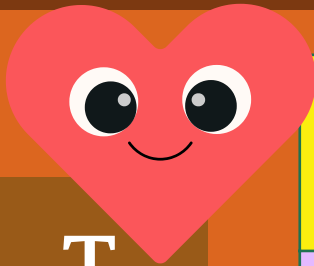

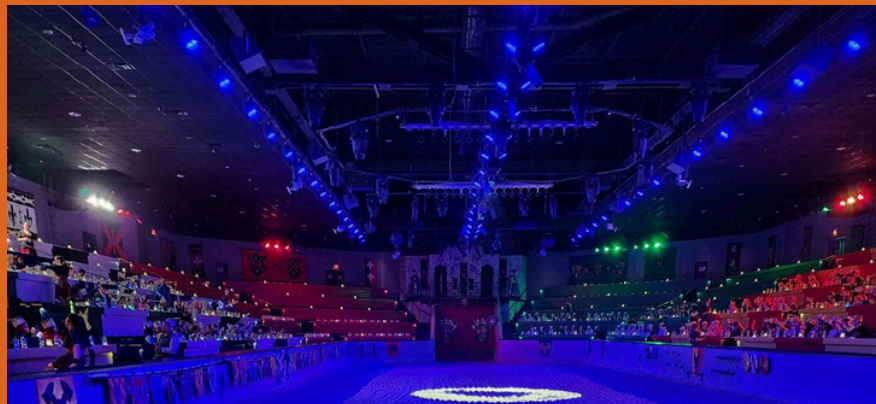

Staff Member at Flint River Community Center

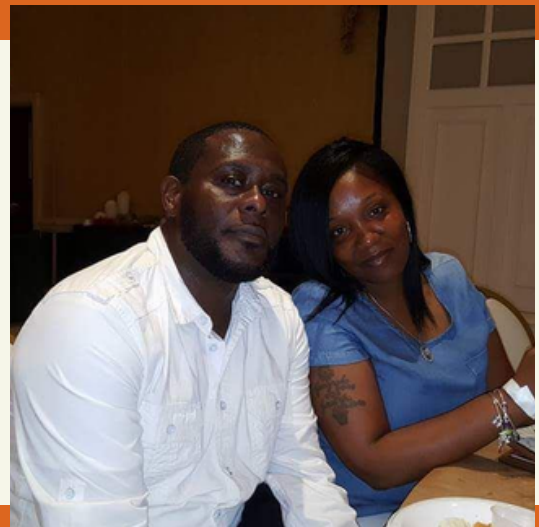
This month, we're proud to shine the spotlight on Anthony Carter, a dedicated and uplifting member of the Flint River Community Center team for the past five years.
